One author will receive the NWA Meteorological Satellite Applications Award, a grant of \$500, and be invited to present a poster at the NWA 36th Annual Meeting in Birmingham, AL on October 15-20, 2011.

Rules: Student papers should not exceed ten (10) pages including images and appendices. The student must be enrolled as an undergraduate at the time the paper is written and be in good academic standing at the college or university attending.
